Petroleum disaster specialists today vacuumed crude oil from a 100-squaremile

spill in calm Atlantic waters as the threat of massive ecological damage to Moroccan oyster beds, prime fishing grounds and nature conservancies receded.

Moroccan naval vessels and helicopters, operating at times no more than 20 miles off the Atlantic coast, sprayed dispersal detergents to break up and sink the floating green crude spilled two weeks ago when the Iranian super tanker Khark 5 exploded, then drifted after the 35-man crew abandoned ship.
